

**Segerstrom Football
Booster Meeting Agenda
February 16, 2023**



- I. **Call the meeting to order at 6:40pm.**
- II. **Approval of Minutes:** Motioned to approve minutes from Booster meeting held on February 16, 2023 by Vanessa Tagaloa; seconded by Heidi Galaviz.
- III. **Treasurer's Monthly Report:** Heidi reviewed Reconciliation Report and Profit/Loss Statement with the members. She will input the 2023 Budget for Operating Expenses when Coach Tagaloa gets the amount calculated. Motioned to approve by Vicky Venegas; seconded by Jennifer Cervantes.
- IV. **Budget:** Budget was not ready for approval; however, Coach Tagaloa will e-mail his budget to Booster members as soon as possible for approval. There are several things he needs to order very soon; such as new red face masks for Varsity helmets, gray jerseys to replenish the ones that were taken with Seniors that left. He also needs to adjust the budget, since Nick Canzone (athletic director) has purchased some much needed equipment for the program. He will also be covering the cost of the Glazier Clinic for the coaches. It costs approximately \$450. Due to timing, Boosters may have to pay upfront, but Canzone will reimburse us for the cost. This clinic is coming up on February 24 at the Hilton in Costa Mesa. Vicky requested purchasing some bins for the snack bar. Also, the purchase of a laptop or ipad for Booster use when selling Grad Night tickets or performing other Booster duties was discussed.
- V. **Fundraising:**
 - A. Frank Stephens said he has some money coming in to the program, but needs another week or so, possibly \$3,000. He is going to reach out to Chick-fil-a to get a money donation to the program.
 - B. AOC Surveys: Coach Tagaloa discussed a fundraising opportunity through AOC. It would entail sending out surveys electronically to family/friends. Each survey completed earns \$0.80 for the program, with a maximum amount earned of \$20,000.
 - C. We will proceed with pretty much the same fundraising we have in the past: cookie dough, Subway cards, stadium shirts, Blast, Lift-a-thon, (possible Poker/Casino Night?)
- VI. **Grad Night Sales:**
 - A. We need cash boxes, poster (Vicky will have that ready), receipt book and keys from Jeanette. Heidi shared log-in information for the Square.
 - B. Jessica will be there on February 23rd at lunch.
 - C. For March, Vicky will go on March 9th and Jessica will go on March 23rd, at lunch. Vanessa will come during her lunch break to help on those dates.
 - D. Price will be capped at \$170 with ASB and \$175 without ASB.
- VII. **Florida Trip**
 - A. KSA sent an invoice to pay via check/credit card for players to complete registrations.
 - B. 33 players have paid the deposit so far (as of 2/16/23); only 3 players had registered online
 - C. We have had 2 parent meetings, several emails/messages sent from Boosters, Coach talks with the players, several emails from KSA, and it just wasn't enough. Deadline is coming up in a few days. Unfortunately, we will not be able to travel to Florida, due to lack of commitment from players/parents.
 - D. Coach will look into a Week 0 game that we can travel to. Week 0 is August 18th. Frank Stephens is going to reach out to contacts in San Diego. Coach Tagaloa will also look into schools north, to see if there is something he can arrange and travel with the team on a shorter/less expensive trip.

- E. We will email parents and let them know that Florida is no longer happening, but that we will hopefully travel somewhere else.

VIII. Snack Bar Clean-Up: We need to purchase bins to keep candy/chips in. Also, the refrigerator is on its last leg, so keep an eye out for a refrigerator. We need to call Coca-Cola to have the fountain drink machine removed. There may be a phone number on the side of the machine. Booster members will come on February 22nd to clean out/organize the snack bar.

IX. Round Table:

- A. Vanessa, Jennifer, and Jessica will go to Bank of America in the next week or so, so that Jennifer and Jessica can be added onto the account. Vanessa will try for Wednesday at 3pm (Feb. 22).
- B. 7 vs. 7 games: There is a game on March 14th at Western High School, as well as a tournament at Western High School on Saturday, June 10th.
- C. Coach Tagaloa and Valley's Coach Freddy Macias are working on a collaboration for a 7vs7 tournament. This would be held at Valley High School, since they have 2 fields and would include all Santa Ana high schools. Details are still being sorted out, as some of the high schools still don't have head coaches at this time. Profits would be split between both programs.
- D. Booster Google Account. We discussed how documents need to be put on the Booster Google account, so that everyone has access to them. Jennifer Cervantes will upload all Booster Meeting Minutes to that Google Account.
- E. Fair Share Donations: Fair Share donation amount will be increased from \$500 to \$700 for this upcoming season. This amount includes fundraising. Buy-out amount is \$700. Players that paid the \$500 deposit for Florida will have this carried over for the fair share donation. Boosters decided that families with more than one player in the program will only have to fundraise \$200 total, instead of \$200 per player.
