

**Segerstrom Football
Booster Meeting Agenda
March 16, 2023**



- I. **Call the meeting to order at 6:44pm**

- II. **Approval of Minutes:** Motioned to approve minutes from Booster meeting held on February 16, 2023 by Vanessa Tagaloa ; seconded by Jessica Amezcua.

- III. **Treasurer's Monthly Report:** Reviewed Reconciliation Report and Profit/Loss Statement with the members. Jessica took care of the 7on7 bill, plus got a discount. She took care of 2 refunds for Florida (Terry Nunez & Aleman family). Motioned to approve the Treasurer reports by Jennifer Cervantes; seconded by Heidi Galaviz.

- IV. **Budget:** Coach wanted to table the topic until later, so he can review the numbers. Jessica to communicate with Coach Tagaloa about his budget and some possible adjustments. However, he did get a quote from a friend, Steven, for backpacks for next season for \$21 each for JV and Varsity. He can get them personalized for Segerstrom football. Members approved.

- V. **Travel Trips**
 - A. **Week 0 Game:** We have confirmed our Week 0 game against San Pasqual High School for the Freshman and Varsity levels on August 18, 2023. Freshman will play at 3pm, but return home after possibly watching the Varsity game. Varsity will stay the weekend. We will be staying Friday and Saturday night (8/18 & 8/19) in the San Diego area. We will look into hotels in the area for costs. At this time, the Varsity roster has 51 players. We would need 20 hotel rooms (including players, coaches, boosters). Coach is hoping to book a college tour (possibly USD) on Saturday and maybe even be able to watch a practice. Then on Sunday, we could either do a beach day or go to the San Diego Zoo Safari Park. Members agreed that the beach day would better suit the team. Boosters will need to provide: team meal @ 3pm in Escondido, post game meal, breakfast/lunch/dinner for Saturday, and breakfast/lunch on Sunday. For JV, Coach is still trying to find a team to play (possibilities include Bellflower, Cypress, Newport Harbor).

 - B. **Atascadero:** We are confirmed to travel to Atascadero again this year for a 7on7 tournament. The dates are June 23-24 and it costs \$300. This is for the skill players and linemen. Approximately 40 players will attend this trip. We will need 15 rooms for this trip and will need to provide players with breakfast/lunch/dinner on Friday 6/23, and breakfast/lunch on Saturday 6/24. Valley High School will be attending this trip as well.

- VI. **Fundraising:** AOC Fundraiser. Families/friends complete surveys of popular companies to earn money for the team. You have to be at least 18 years old to participate. Each person completes 50 surveys to earn \$40 for the team. Surveys take about 1 minute to complete and are emoji based. We are

encouraging each player to send the link out to at least 5 people. The company will give us up to \$7,500 (with the possibility of more).

- VII. Grad Night Sales:** Vanessa and Jessica will be at the school on March 23 and March 24 at both lunches. Alejandra will go during lunch on March 29th (Vanessa will come during her lunch break). Heidi, Jessica, and Ivonne Ontiveros will go on March 30 during Open House. Also, the QR code to pay should be posted on social media. Last day to purchase will be April 21. Coach said a student has been emailing the Grad Night email address without a response, so we need to make sure we are checking that email. Heidi will email Julie about all of the March Grad Night dates. She will also send an email about the April dates when we figure them out. We need chaperones for Grad Night (1 for every 15 kids). Grad Night is June 2nd. Coach will be putting together a list of chaperones. It is opened up to boosters first, then others. Any booster member that would like to attend needs to let Coach know.
- VIII. Snack Bar:** The snack bar food was cleaned out in February. The grill we have does not work well, as it gathers grease in a puddle. We are going to try and sell the grill and purchase a newer, simpler one. Also, we really need a new refrigerator. Vanessa suggested looking into doing a wrap in the snack bar, with a customized design to give the snack bar a updated look. We still need to figure out how to get the Coca Cola machine removed from the snack bar, as it takes up a lot of room. We discussed having a 2 shift requirement at the snack bar for Freshman parents. Coach Tagaloa will include that in the contract that parents sign before the season starts. Also, if we can get enough parents this season, we can go back to having 2 shifts for home game snack bars. We discussed having a possible incentive for working at the snack bar (for JV and Varsity parents). For example, for every snack bar you work, you can subtract a certain amount of money from the fair share donation.
- IX. Round Table:**
- A. **Water girls:** Only 4 girls have filled out the Google Form. Coach needs between 4-6 water girls.
 - B. **Dead period** is from 6/3-6/18. Players return to practice on 6/19.
 - C. **Family BBQ is on 8/5. Fullerton Scrimmage is on 8/11. Jaguar Extravaganza is on 8/12.**
We will be having a full snack bar for the Fullerton Scrimmage, as all 3 levels will be playing at Segerstrom (3pm, 5pm, 7pm). Shopping for these events will probably have to happen on 8/4 and 8/10.
 - D. Vanessa to email Mark about website, meeting minutes, and Booster member updates. Booster members to read the by-laws and we will vote to make any changes next meeting.
 - E. **Coach Frank Stephens:**
 - 1. He spoke to Tony Stewart, owner of the Chick-fil-a. He wants to continue to donate team pre-game meals.
 - 2. There is a check for \$3,000 from Pat Donahue and his foundation (Orange County Community Foundation) that was mailed out to our P.O. Box. He would like confirmation that it was received. Jessica confirmed we received it on Saturday 3/18.
 - 3. Frank spoke with a contact at the Segerstrom Company. He needs an email requesting funds to be sent.

4. Andy Meyer would like to get together with Coach Tagaloa to see if there is something we can earmark for him to help fund.
- F. Kelley Orellana brought up the idea of doing a Skate Night. We will look into what their experience is with the high school level.
- G. Merchandise: Coach would like to order stadium shirts, Freshman incentives, hats (for coaches), and weightlifting shirts earlier this year. Check for other businesses to get shirts made. Jessica to check into a non-profit for shirts.
- H. Coach Tagaloa was asked by Principal Casper if there was a way to sponsor a student in need, Kevin Duarte, for Grad Night. Motioned to approve by Jessica, members unanimously agreed to sponsor this student for his Grad Night ticket.
- I. Coach Tagaloa is to have football try-outs the week of 3/20 for students not currently on the football team, so there may end up being more players on the roster.
- J. Parent meeting for JV and Varsity will happen the week of April 17th. We will collect fair share donations, go over dates for upcoming events, sell merchandise. Coach would like to have the meeting on April 17th, but still needs to confirm availability of the theater. Once confirmed, Jennifer will send out an email and message via GroupMe.
- K. Parent meeting for incoming Freshmen: Coach wasn't sure if there was going to be an Open House for incoming students. Since the booster meeting, we have received information about the Athletics Open House occurring on May 4th from 5:30-7pm. We need to have a table with handouts and sign up sheets.
