

**Segerstrom Football
Booster Meeting Minutes
June 15, 2023**



- I. Call the meeting to order at 6:51pm**
- II. Approval of Minutes:** Motioned to approve minutes from Booster meeting held on May 18, 2023 by Vicky Venegas; seconded by Heidi Galaviz .
- III. Treasurer's Monthly Report:** Jessica Amezcua presented Reconciliation and Profit & Loss Statement. Motioned to approve by Vicky Venegas; seconded by Jennifer Cervantes
- IV. Budget:**
 - Some BSN orders to be dated for September (ex- decals for helmets). Coach just put order in.
 - Coach also ordered replacement jerseys.
 - Coach still needs trash cans (24), wristbands for play calling, and footballs (we had 12, now only have 9). Coach would like to purchase game footballs with red laces to use just for games. They cost about \$120 each.
 - We still have to pay for the pride pack.
- V. Travel Trip**
 - A. Week 0 Game vs San Pasqual HS (Aug. 18-20)**
 - Freshman play at 4pm, Varsity at 7pm. Coach is trying to get approval so that the Freshman team can stay and watch the Varsity game. We will need to provide the freshman team with a post game meal, even if they do not stay for the later game.
 - Only the Varsity team will be staying in San Diego for the weekend. We have booked the hotel (Holiday Inn Express in Old Town San Diego). 23 rooms, \$225/night, per room. (As of 6/21, we have added one additional room for Mark Bausman). We will need to provide meals for the players all weekend (breakfast is provided at the hotel).
- VI. Fundraising**
 - We finished the Subway cards. We will still be selling cookie dough and stadium shirts.
 - If we are to continue to do Universal Studios, we need to let them know asap. Heidi Galaviz received an email from Universal. Cost per ticket has increased to \$99.
 - Poker/Bingo Night is tentatively scheduled for Sept. 29th, location undetermined.
- VII. Summer Events**
 - A. Alumni Game, June 30 (BBQ post game)**
 - Scheduled for 5pm. Coach has only received messages from 2 alumni that plan to play. Coach to post another ad and request RSVP, so we can get a headcount for BBQ.
 - B. Santiago HS Scrimmage in Corona, July 22 (food)**
 - Starts at 8am
 - We will provide lunch (sandwich, fruit, chips, drink) and snacks.
 - This is a 7 on 7 and a 5 on 5 tournament, Varsity only
 - C. Family BBQ (Aug. 5)**
 - We will send information out to parents, as to what type of food/drink to bring
 - All levels play and then there is a BBQ afterwards.

D. Jaguar Extravaganza (Aug. 12)

- This is for JV and Varsity only. It is an all day experience for the players. They will watch film from the scrimmage with Fullerton (from the day before) and will then do different team bonding activities and take care of the beginning of season business.
- Boosters to provide breakfast, lunch, and dinner for the event.

VIII. Snack Bar

- A. Sign-Up list** : We will need 15 parents signed up for each snack bar shift. One shift is the whole game. Jennifer to create a Sign-Up Genius. She will send out a message to parents to get more slots filled.
- B. Shopping** : We will go shopping on August 10th for the snack bar, as there are home games the next day (Fullerton Scrimmage).
- C. Fullerton Scrimmage (Aug. 11th)**: Freshman play at 3pm, JV at 4pm, Varsity at 5pm. Snack bar will be open and we already have enough freshman parents signed up to help. However, we will need some JV/Varsity parents to help at the snack bar for the 3pm game.

XI. Varsity Team Meals:

- We will need Varsity team meals for all games. There are 75 people to feed (players & coaches).

XII. Freshman Representative: We don't need a Freshman Representative. However, Jackie Garcia (a freshman parent) has volunteered to help confirm snack bar volunteers and fill open slots. Jennifer Cervantes to be in contact with Jackie.

- Coach needs boosters to book a place to stay for Coaches Weekend, July 14-16th. Booking an Airbnb house in San Diego was suggested.
